

Fox On A Hill Privacy Policy

Fox On A Hill, LLC. (“**FOAH**” or “**we**”) operates FoxOnAHill.com (“**Website**” or “**Site**”). This Privacy Policy describes FOAH’s use and potential sharing of personally identifiable information (your full name, email address, mailing address, telephone number, or credit card number) that Users voluntarily provide to FOAH when they wish to join a subscription, post a comment, be informed of updates or performances and events and when they wish purchase downloadable content of other merchandise from the Website (also known as “**Registration Data**” or “**RD**”). The Term “**User**” refers to **You** as a Visitor, or as an Interested User that supplies personal information, or as a Purchaser of downloads or merchandise. This Privacy Policy applies to all services offered by FOAH through the FoxOnAHill.com web site and any other ancillary uses and applications that may be included with the any FOAH user services or derived therefrom (**FOAH Services**).

The FOAH Website is a general audience site and does not knowingly collect RD from children under 13 years of age. The Website is available for individuals aged 13 years or older. If you are 13 or older but under the age of 18, you should review these terms and conditions with your parent or guardian to make sure that you and your parent or guardian understand these terms and conditions.

From time to time FOAH may modify this Privacy Policy to reflect industry initiatives or changes in the law, our RD collection and use practices, the features of the FOAH Services, or technology, and such modifications shall be effective upon posting by FOAH on the FOAH Website. Your continued use of the FOAH Services after FOAH posts a revised Privacy Policy signifies your acceptance of the revised Privacy Policy. It is therefore important that you review this Privacy Policy regularly to ensure you are updated as to any changes. If FOAH materially changes its practices regarding collection or use of your RD, your RD will continue to be governed by the Policy under which it was collected unless you have been provided notice of, and have not objected to, the change.

1. FOAH’S COLLECTION OF REGISTRATION DATA AND NON-REGISTRATION DATA

GENERAL. When FOAH collects RD from you it is because you are voluntarily submitting Registration Data to us in order to register as a Member of FOAH. FOAH may also collect RD from you if you choose to participate in FOAH Services activities like sweepstakes, contests, and surveys, because you want us to furnish you with products, services, newsletters, or information, or in connection with content or suggestions you submit to FOAH for review.

In addition, FOAH collects other non-Registration Data including IP address, aggregate user RD, and browser type. This information is used to manage and improve the FOAH Services, track usage, and for security purposes.

FOAH Users may also choose to provide or store non-RD information in their profiles, including but not limited to date of birth, interests, hobbies, lifestyle choices, groups with whom they are affiliated (schools, companies), videos and/or pictures, private messages, bulletins or personal statements (collectively “**Profile Information**”). The Profile Information in a Member’s profile is provided at his or her sole discretion. FOAH Users can change their Registration RD and Profile Information at any time and can

control how Visitors, other Users and FOAH communicate with them by controlling their account settings.

FOAH does not sell, rent or lease its user lists to third parties. FOAH may, from time to time, contact you on behalf of external business partners about a particular offering that may be of interest to you. In those cases, your unique personally identifiable information (e-mail, name, address, telephone number) is not transferred to the third party. In addition, FOAH may share data with trusted partners to help us perform statistical analysis, send you e-mail or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to FOAH, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information. FOAH does not use or disclose sensitive personal information, such as race, religion, sexual orientation or political affiliations, without your explicit consent.

FOAH keeps track of the pages users visit within the Site in order to determine what FOAH services are the most popular. This data is used to deliver customized content within FOAH to Users whose behavior indicates that they are interested in a particular subject area. FOAH will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) protect the security of the Site; (b) to take any precautions against liability FOAH deems necessary or advisable; (c) to respond to judicial process and subpoenas; or (d) to the extent permitted under provisions of applicable federal, state or local law; and/or to provide information to law enforcement agencies or for an investigation related to public safety or welfare.

COOKIES. Cookies are small bits of information that FOAH places on your computer to identify your Internet browser, store Users' preferences, and determine whether you have installed the enabling software needed to access certain material on the FOAH Services. RD in cookies may be read to authenticate user sessions or provide services.

Third party advertisements displayed on FOAH Services may also contain cookies set by Internet advertising companies or advertisers (known as "third party cookies"). FOAH does not control these third party cookies and Users of the FOAH Services should check the privacy policy of the Internet advertising company or advertiser to see whether and how it uses cookies. A pixel tag is a tiny image inserted in a webpage and used to record the number and types of views for that page. FOAH may allow third party pixel tags to be present on FOAH Services for purposes of advertising, providing services or RD and statistics collection.

You can program your computer to warn you each time a cookie is being sent, block third party cookies or block all cookies. However, by blocking all cookies you may not have access to certain features on the FOAH Services.

2. NOTICE: FOAH'S REGISTRATION DATA COLLECTION PRACTICES

FOAH Services may be linked to Internet sites operated by other companies and may also carry advertisements from other companies. FOAH is not responsible for the privacy practices of websites or other services operated by third parties that are linked to or integrated with the FOAH Services or for the privacy practices of third party Internet advertising companies. Once you leave FOAH Services via such a link, access a third

party application or click on an advertisement, you should check the applicable privacy policy of the third party or advertiser site to determine, among other things, how they will handle any RD they collect from you. FOAH Services may also be linked to sites operated by companies affiliated with FOAH. Users who visit those Affiliated Company sites should still refer to their separate privacy policies and practices, which may differ in some respects from this Privacy Policy.

FOAH may use cookies and similar tools to customize the content and advertising you receive based on the Profile Information you have provided. The information used for this feature does not provide your RD or identify you as an individual to third parties.

Third party applications (such as widgets) created by third party developers may also be available on the FOAH Services such as the DownloadCentric Corporation who operates the FOAH Download Store. When a User engages with a third party application, that User is interacting with the third party developer, not with FOAH. FOAH encourages Users not to provide RD to the third party's application unless the User knows the party with whom it is interacting. Third party applications such as DownloadCentric will have their own Privacy policy rules, which can be accessed from the FOAH store page or from the third party's home page. Information gathered by the Third Party shall be governed by the third party's Privacy Policy.

3. CHOICE: FOAH WILL PROVIDE YOU WITH CHOICES ABOUT THE USE OF YOUR REGISTRATION DATA

Except as described in this Privacy Policy, FOAH will get your permission before we use the RD you provide to us in a way that is inconsistent with the purpose for which it was submitted or share your RD with third parties that are not affiliated with FOAH.

4. USE: FOAH'S USE OF REGISTRATION DATA

FOAH will only use the RD you provide under this Privacy Policy in a manner that is consistent with this Privacy Policy. If FOAH obtains RD from a third party, such as a business partner, our use of that information is also governed by this Privacy Policy.

If you have consented to receive promotional materials (e.g., newsletters) or notifications from FOAH, FOAH may periodically use your email address to send you such materials related to the FOAH Services, as applicable. If you want to stop receiving such materials from FOAH, you can change your profile settings under "Account Settings," or follow the unsubscribe instructions at the bottom of each email.

FOAH employees, agents and contractors must have a business reason to obtain access to your RD. FOAH may share your RD with those who help us manage or provide FOAH Services' information activities (for example, message board administration, order fulfillment, statistical analyses, RD processing), or with outside contractors, agents or sponsors who help us with the administration, judging and prize fulfillment aspects of contests, promotions and sweepstakes.

These outside contractors, agents or sponsors may temporarily store some information on their servers, but they may only use your RD to provide FOAH with a specific service and not for any other purpose. FOAH may also provide your RD to a third party in those instances where you have chosen to receive certain information and have been notified that the fulfillment of such a request requires the sharing of your RD. FOAH also may share your RD with Affiliated Companies if it has a business reason to do so.

As described in "Notice" above, FOAH may customize the advertising and marketing messages you receive on the FOAH Website, or may work with outside companies to do so. Your non-RD and/or Profile Information may be shared with these companies so this customization can be accomplished. FOAH prohibits these companies from sharing your non-RD and/or Profile Information with any third party or from using it for any other purpose. Anonymous click stream, number of page views calculated by pixel tags, and aggregated demographic information may also be shared with FOAH's advertisers and business partners.

There may be instances when FOAH may access or disclose RD, Profile Information or non-RD without providing you a choice in order to: (i) protect or defend the legal rights or property of FOAH, our Affiliated Companies or their employees, agents and contractors (including enforcement of our agreements); (ii) protect the safety and security of Users of the FOAH Services or Users of the public including acting in urgent circumstances; (iii) protect against fraud or for risk management purposes; or (iv) comply with the law or legal process. In addition, if FOAH sells all or part of its business or makes a sale or transfer of all or a material part of its assets or is otherwise involved in a merger or transfer of all or a material part of its business, FOAH may transfer your RD to the party or parties involved in the transaction as part of that transaction.

5. SECURITY: FOAH PROTECTS THE SECURITY OF REGISTRATION DATA

FOAH uses commercially reasonable administrative, technical, personnel and physical measures to safeguard RD and credit card information in its possession against loss, theft and unauthorized use, disclosure or modification. In addition, FOAH uses reasonable methods to make sure that RD is accurate, up-to-date and appropriately complete.

6. ACCESS, REMEDIES AND COMPLIANCE: HOW TO EDIT YOUR PREFERENCES REGARDING YOUR RD AND HOW TO CONTACT FOAH ABOUT PRIVACY CONCERNS

Whenever possible, FOAH Users may review the Registration RD we maintain about them in our records. We will take reasonable steps to correct any RD a User informs us is incorrect. If you ask FOAH to stop using your RD, FOAH will honor that request while retaining any record of your RD that is necessary to comply with applicable federal, state or local law.
